

District Manager, Frank Sakuma called the December 14, 2023, Tradition Lake Banks Committee Meeting to order at 11:00 p.m. in the Tradition Town Hall located at 10799 SW Civic Lane, Port St. Lucie, Florida 34987.

#### **D. NEW BUSINESS**

#### 1. Approval of June 28, 2023, Committee Meeting Minutes

A **motion** was made by Ms. Milmore, seconded by Mr. Krbec and passed unanimously approving the June 28, 2023, minutes.

#### 2. Committee Discussion

Mr. Sakuma reviewed the Solitude Lake Management contract updates.

Ms. King asked who oversees treating the control level area down to the lake.

Ms. King and Mr. Krbec asked that the HOA's be sent a letter clarifying what areas the CDD covers and what areas the HOA is responsible for.

A **motion** was made by Ms. King, seconded by Mr. Krbec and passed unanimously approving a letter to be sent to the HOA's regarding lake maintenance responsibilities.

Dr. Powers inquired about the lake and wetland reports. Ms. Cranford stated that the reports are ongoing but can send a spreadsheet to anyone who needs it.

Ms. King would like a credit back from Solitude Lake Management for all the missing reports.

The committee wants to investigate other vendors for the lake and wetlands maintenance.

A **motion** was made by Dr. Powers, seconded by Mr. Lasher and passed unanimously recommending Tradition CDD No. 1 to provide new RFP's for scope of work for the lake and wetlands maintenance, including the control level areas.

Dr. Powers asked if we had used the drone/lidar imaging for the lake bank areas. Ms. Cranford stated this item had been tabled at the last CDD meeting.

A **motion** was made by Ms. Milmore, seconded by Mr. Siedlecki and passed unanimously recommending Tradition CDD No. 1 to provide a proposal for lidar scanning via drone for all lakes. It was also asked that the HOA's be notified when the drone is in use.

Ms. Cranford reviewed how the lake basin's function.

Mr. Sakuma discussed which funds would be used for the drones and any lake restoration.

Ms. Powers asked to see the current version of the lake and wetlands turnover criteria.

Mr. Pagan inquired about the best way to restore the main lake banks. Ms. Cranford suggested a living shoreline is the most economical.

Ms. Cranford explained how an RFQ works.

The Committee then asked for the Master and Supplemental Engineer Report to be sent to them for review.

The next meeting date was discussed.
